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## Share these special curated locations and experiences with us for an unforgettable journey!

~ **Day 1** ~ Your day of arrival at Zagreb airport is finally here! You will be chauffeured by dedicated transportation, where we gather and meet our fellow travelers at the selected location/accommodation. You will settle in for the next 4 nights and prepare for our *Welcome Dinner* tonight.

~ **Day 2** ~ Good morning! Recharge and acclimate at Top-Terme, Topusko, and the River Kupa. Enjoy the local thermal baths, as well as the beauty and nature around you. Massages are possible *by prearranged appointments only*. Today we will eat an early dinner at the Top-Terme restaurant. We should all be rested up now!

~ **Day 3** ~ Full day excursion. An early departure takes us to UNESCO-listed Plitvice Lakes. No trip to Croatia is complete without a visit to this jewel of a national park. You will be amazed at the 16 interconnected lakes, breathtakingly beautiful any time of the year. Enjoy the humming waterfalls bounding across wooden pathways surrounded by fir, beech, and spruce trees. The lakes are famous for their stunning colors which change from shades of teal, turquoise and dark blues, due to the high mineral content in the water. You will experience this firsthand, as you enjoy a boat ride on the largest lake at the park. Dinner will be caught fresh locally and cooked for you at a specialty restaurant situated nearby.

~ **Day 4** ~ A full day with our professional guide in upper (old) and new town Zagreb begins after breakfast and morning meditation. With love in my heart for my treasured county, we will explore this city where the architecture dates back to the 15<sup>th</sup> century Austro-Hungarian Empire. Visit the open air Dolac Market, where traders from all over Croatia have been coming to sell their wares for over 80 years. We can share stories when we meet over a coffee and the famous "kremsnita" pastry at Vincek! Let's finish the day with panache at the Vinodol restaurant, replete with its charming garden setting, a perfect end to a perfect day.

~ **Day 5** ~ After breakfast we leave our current home setting and embark on a new adventure, leading us to the Istrian Peninsula, and the charming fisherman's village of Fazana. Here we unpack at the small boutique hotel, Villetta Phaisiana, right by the Adriatic Sea, or as the locals call it, "riva". Before we arrive, we will be exploring the prehistoric Postojna Caves, Slovenia, where we have the opportunity to be in a cathedral sized cave with concert-like acoustics, immersed in a world of crystals.

~ **Day 6** ~ Rovinj - Olive Oil Tasting - St. Foska church. After breakfast, served on the picturesque piazza, we venture out to find the old stone "St. Foska" church amidst an olive grove. Here we settle into a vortex of gentle energy as we meditate in harmony. Time to embark on a walking tour through the ages in the charmed city of Rovinj, as she sits on a cliff surrounded by the deep blue colors of the Adriatic. The day includes olive oil tastings and a delightful dinner with local specialties.

~ **Day 7** ~ We will visit Pula, a town with a fully standing Colosseum, marking the time of Roman presence and culture. A guided tour understanding ancient and current history will follow, but before we arrive, we embark on a boat near our hotel, which will take us along the coast and into the Lim Channel (Limski Fjord), a remnant of the ice age. Today's lunch will be served right on the boat!

~ **Day 8** ~ We will be leaving the coast before returning to Zagreb, but not without visiting Motovun to experience truffles, truffles, truffles. It is hard to say goodbye to our lovely Fazana, but our scenic ride will make you think you are in Tuscany. Every hill is crowned with a medieval town and rich red soil full of iron and minerals. Motovun is one such town, situated right in the middle of white and black truffle territory.

As we climb up the old cobble stone road towards the center of town, we will work up an appetite for an unforgettable lunch with endless... guess what? Truffles! As night falls, we return to the country setting, where we will spend one evening in our original hotel before departing in the morning.

~ **Day 9** ~ Today we take a short flight to Sarajevo. Upon arriving, we are transported to the town of Visoko, where we remain for the rest of our trip at the Vema Hotel. This establishment has a wonderful restaurant, and you will see for yourselves when “dinner is served” this evening!

~ **Day 10** ~ Today is the Fall Equinox of the sun, a fortuitous time to visit the archeological digs at the Bosnian Pyramids, and join their educational program. Over two days we will wonder at the spectacular vistas and meaning of this ancient valley. Lunch will be at Ravne Park, then on to the underground labyrinth with its amazing healing chambers. At the end of the day, we will return to Vema Hotel for dinner.

~ **Day 11** ~ Let's explore the scalar energies of the Ravne tunnels, upon which sits the Pyramid of the Moon. We will learn more about its discovery and structure. Can you imagine having an out-of-body experience; it has been known to happen if you let it in. At this location, we will have an unforgettable lunch atop the pyramid prepared by locals and cooked over open fires; not one modern cooking apparatus in sight. After, we will enjoy a special group mediation. Although full, dinner will be back at our hotel.

~ **Day 12** ~ Pack a bag for our overnight trip to Medjugorje, with an early departure and a first stop in Mostar. We will enjoy a guided tour and walk over the famous arched bridge, where you will be dazzled as East meets West. Two great civilizations lived as two separate entities here; the Austro-Hungarian and Ottoman empires. We will visit a traditional home recreated in the likeness of the Turkish architecture from long ago. The day ends in Medjugorje, where we will rest overnight at the charming “Herzeg Etno Selo”.

~ **Day 13** ~ Medjugorje has become a world renown pilgrimage site for all people since the 80s when Mother Mary appeared to six local children. Her apparitions and messages given to the six children were about praying for peace. Alas, 10 years later, the horrible war began and many lives and livelihoods were lost. On our way back to Visoko we will visit the beautiful Kravice Waterfalls, a place of enchantment. Wade or bathe in the cool waters of the falls (weather permitting) and allow your burdens to be washed away. We continue to another sacred place, the Blagaj Tekki, monastery of the Sufi, carved into a rock and situated right at the spot where the river Buna emerges. We will eat an early dinner at the monastery, then back to Hotel Vema in Visoko.

~ **Day 14** ~ Sarajevo Old Town is our destination, for shopping, exploring, and a specialty lunch in town. This modern city is filled with little coffee shops, artisans, restaurants, and galleries. Here you can have a cup of Turkish coffee and a typical ‘burek’ and eat like the locals do. You might remember to pack an extra folding travel tote with you; lots of souvenirs to bring home from the the cobble street we call the “Barcasija”. We will have a farewell dinner and if you wish, some time on your own to take in the city at night. Tomorrow we depart for home or as stated below, arrangements can be made for you to extend your stay in many ways.

~ **Day 15** ~ Departure from Sarajevo airport. Note: Arrangements may be made prior with the help of your host, to extend your experience at the Bosnian Pyramids, Dubrovnik, coastal towns, and more!
